FINAL WEDDING CONSULTATION

We will no doubt be in touch throughout the planning process but at this point, make sure we can squeeze in a few minutes for coffee. I will need you to give me a list of locations you have settled on, the address and time for the ceremony and reception, as well as a list of family formals you would like to have so no one feels forgotten in the excitement of the day

It is important that anyone who you have listed to be in formals is aware of the time and location to meet. As soon as the recieving line has ended, and as near to the church as possible is the best place to do these to avoid confusion.



Prior to your wedding, we will create a timeline to make your day run smoothly!

It really helps the flow of the day if I photograph your family portraits first. That way, your parents and grandparents can go relax while I capture you guys having fun with the bridal party. When that's done, they can rest their feet in the limo while I get those incredibly special photos of the two of you together!

Location wise, there are so many great places. Whether you decide to stick with the traditional locations around town or put your own unique spin on things, I will make sure you get beautiful and timeless portraits.

When discussing locations, think about fun things like where you met and how, where you had your first date and your favorite place to spend time together. It doesn't hurt if those places have stunning panaramic views, but if the location is meaningful, the backdrop will be special to you.

GOOD TO KNOW

How far in advance should we book?


It is important you book your photographer as soon as you have chosen them. I typically book about 12-18 months in advance, so if your date is available I suggest booking it as soon as you have chosen me as your photographer. I hold a date for 48 hour following an inquiry to allow time for decision making. From there we arrange a contract signing and payment of the retainer.


When are payments due?

To make paying for your wedding photography easier, you total payment will be divided into three payments. The first payment is a non-refundable retainer payable when the contract is signed to hold the date. The second payment is due half way between contract signing and the wedding, and the final payment is due a month prior to the wedding. If travel charges are applicable, those will be due the same day as the final payment. All prices are subject to tax.

When will I get to see my wedding photos?

Depending on what time of year your wedding is, the timeline could vary. You should see some previews within a week of your wedding with your final images delivered within 8-16 weeks.

The excitement, anticipation, and the planning...oh the planning!
